

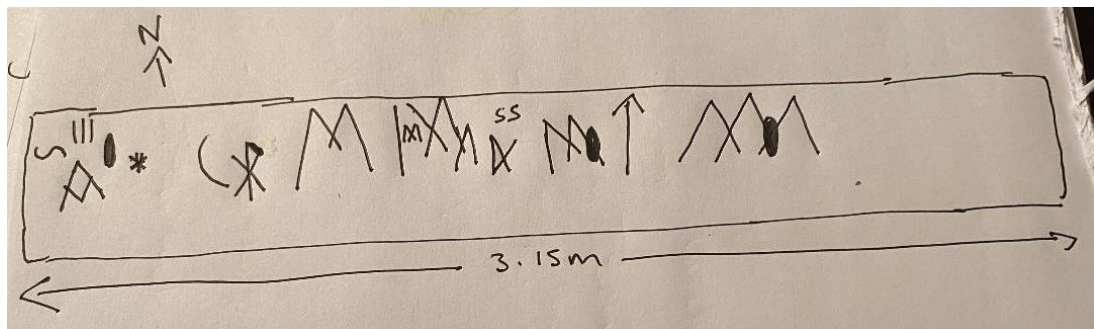

Context: Part of a late 15th Century Hall house (circa 1471) town house now subdivided into 3. Central section. Floor and chimney inserted later.

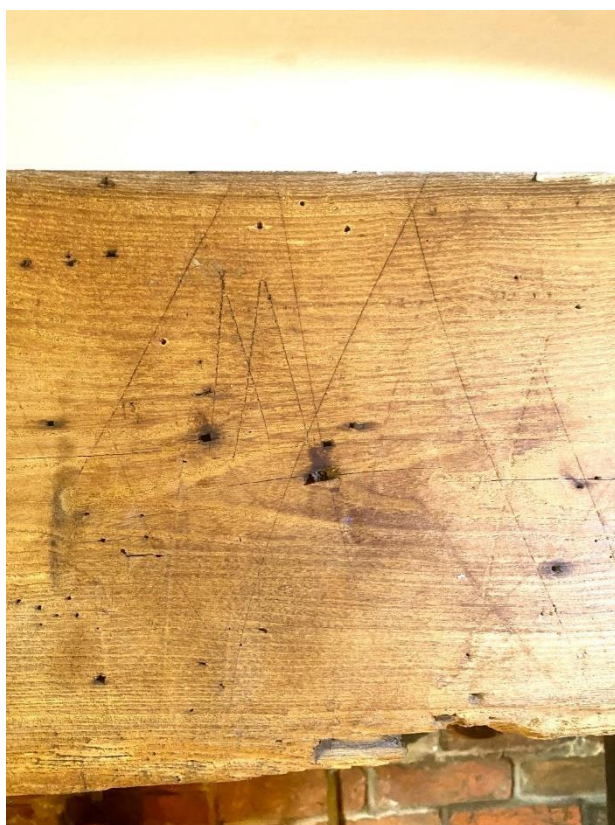
All the house searched but marks only on the Bressummer which itself had been heavily sand blasted.

Marks present – at least 5 M, one AM, upward pointing arrow, S and SS stamps, star stamp, 3 burn marks (one through an M), one possible Chi-rho monogram, 3 strike marks, one possible butterfly mark.

Length of bressummer = 3.15m
